### HOW DO WE APPLY THE BIBLE?

#### 2 Timothy 2:15

Are there divisions in the Bible that need to be considered to apply it properly?  
YES  or NO

Can we ignore those divisions in the Bible and stand approved before God? YES  or NO

Is there any work involved in learning God's will so that He can be pleased with our service?  
YES  or NO

#### Deuteronomy 5:1-22

Was the covenant God gave to the nation of Israel (later known as the nation of the Jews) through Moses given at Mount Horeb (also known as Mount Sinai)? (Look especially at verse 2.)  
YES  or NO

Was the covenant God gave to Israel (also known as the "Law of Moses") binding on anybody before the Israelites arrived at mount Horeb? (Look especially at verse 3.) YES  or NO

Were the 10 commandments part of this law that was given at mount Horeb? (Look especially at verses 7 through 22.) YES  or NO

Were the 10 commandments in force before the Israelites arrived at mount Horeb?  
YES  or NO

#### Colossians 2:14, Galatians 3:24-25

Did the Law of Moses cease to be binding on man at the cross of Christ? YES  or NO

Are we under the Law of Moses after the cross of Christ? YES  or NO

#### Romans 15:4

Can the Old Testament help us to learn about the nature of God today? YES  or NO

Can we learn about the nature of God from the Law of Moses in the Old Testament?  
YES  or NO

Are the writings of the prophets under the Old Testament of any value to us today?  
YES  or NO

#### Hebrews 1:1-2

Did God send prophets to speak to man in earlier periods of time? YES  or NO

Is this period of time in which Jesus has spoken to us (the New Covenant or New Testament age) called by the writer of the book of Hebrews the "last days"?

#### Acts 2:1-17

Did the Apostle Peter say that the Prophet Joel spoke about the coming of the last days? (verse 16-17)

Did Peter say that the last days as spoken of by the prophet Joel had come during his lifetime? (verse 16-17) YES  or NO

#### Exodus 26:31-33

Was the veil of the temple used to separate man from the very presence of God, who said that he would

dwell in the Holy of Holies in the Temple.

#### Matthew 15:37-39

Would it generally be easier for a man to tear a heavy curtain which was hung high off the floor (as was the veil in the Temple) from the top or from the bottom. Top  or Bottom

If the heavy curtain separating man from God in the Temple was torn from the top that would seem to indicate that God removed that separation not men. YES  or NO

#### Ephesians 2:11-15

Under the Law of Moses, God worked almost exclusively through the Jewish nation but now under the New Covenant (Gospel Age) is there any distinction between Jew and Gentile as far as God is concerned? YES  or NO

Under the new covenant do we have direct access to God through the blood of Christ?

#### 1 Peter 2:5-9, Hebrews 4:14-16, I Timothy 2:5

Under the New Covenant does Christ Jesus, God's son intercede for us with God?

Under the new covenant do we need a human priest to intercede for us with God like God's people under the Law of Moses did? (Look
