

Interactive Bible Study

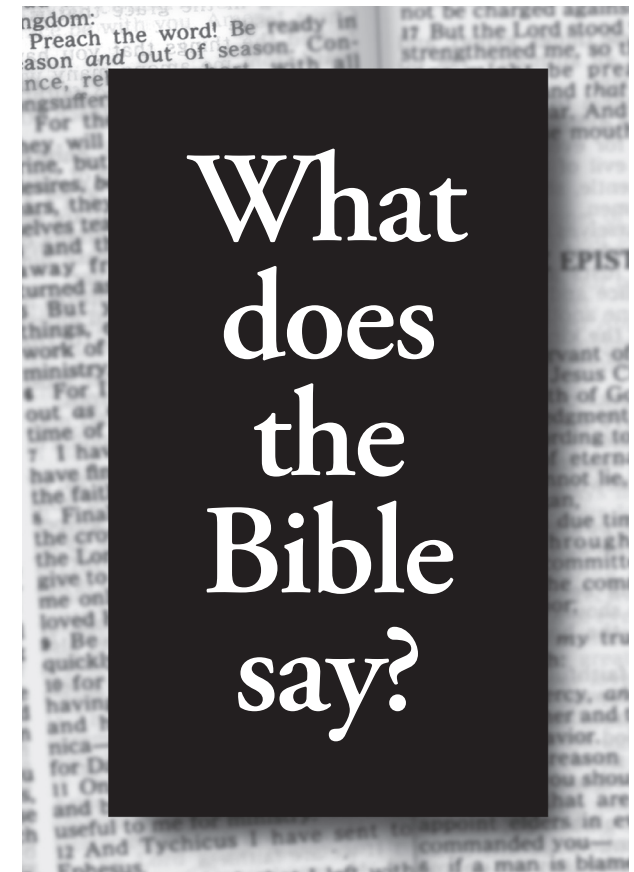

What is the nature of God? What is Sin and what is God's attitude toward sin?

People talk about "being saved." Why is there a need to be saved?

Why do we have a problem with the God who created us? Why is there a need for us to get our relationship right with God?

1 Peter 1:15-16

Is God holy? YES or NO
