

Once we do these things we become followers of Christ because we have done both what Jesus and our Heavenly Father have told us to do and God adds us to the Lord's church. YES or NO

Interactive Bible Study #4

What must I do to be saved?

LESSON 4

WHAT MUST I DO TO BE SAVED?

What must I do to be saved? It is a question that some men asked in Acts 2:37. It is an important question that each of us is responsible to answer before God. Let's look at what the Bible says about this important question.

Acts 8:26-39

Does Bible baptism involve water? (see especially verse 36) YES or NO

When somebody preaches the Gospel of Christ, does that teaching or preaching include Baptism? (see especially verses 35-36) YES or NO

Phillip used a canteen that the Ethiopian Eunuch had in the chariot to sprinkle water on him and called that baptism because it was a lot easier than going down into a potentially dangerous body of water which might not have been very clean. (see especially verses 38 & 39) TRUE or FALSE

Phillip went down into the water with the Ethiopian Eunuch to baptise him. (see especially verses 38 & 39) TRUE or FALSE

The Ethiopian Eunuch understood who Jesus is and confessed his conviction that Jesus is the Christ the son of God before Phillip baptized him. YES or NO
